## Warwick House Closure Order Extended

We have previously reported the closure order obtained on Warwick House (above), in Nuneaton, due to anti-social-behaviour. Inspector Ryan Walker, of Nuneaton and Bedworth Safer Neighbourhood Team, is pleased to inform you that in February the order was extended for a further three months. He said: "We still have concerns around the safety of Warwick House and sought an extension to the closure order while we consult with the landlord on how improvements can be made to the premises. Making and keeping our towns safe remains a priority for us, and we will continue to work hard with partners to understand where vulnerabilities lie in our communities."



Nuneaton North SNT received a report of a motorbike dumped in trees on Galley Common in February. PCSO 8850 Brooks took the report, attended the location and located the vehicle, and arranged the recovery.

Your report will then enable us to locate vehicles such as this, in a much faster timescale. This means we can then arrange for their prompt recovery.

## Prolific Thief Sent to Prison

Sam Proctor, 36, from Nuneaton, appeared at Warwick Crown Court in March, after pleading guilty to a number of offences including burglary, theft, and handling stolen goods. He was sentenced to 40 months in prison and must pay a victim's surcharge of £228. All of the offences took place in the Nuneaton area, including Horeston Grange, Weddington, Attleborough and Hilltop. The investigating Officer, Detective Sergeant Alan Gardner commented, "We would like to thank the victims and witnesses that helped us with this case, providing the evidence that resulted in Proctor's guilty plea. It's been great being able to give the victims of these burglaries the reassurance that Proctor has been suitably punished for his crimes."



On the 20th March, Nuneaton East SNT were out on foot patrol and took the opportunity to visit some of the businesses in the area to see whether they were having any issues. We also visited two of the independent living accommodation sites in Weddington, Reg Haddon and the Chines, to speak to the residents.



We spoke about the importance of the emergency services and the role of the police. They were very interested and then got to look inside our police vehicle and were shown all of the various equipment we use.

**DRUG DRIVING.** Whilst out on patrol in February, PC Lock and PCSO Lovegrove of Bedworth SNT stopped a vehicle on Smorrall Lane, which was seen driving erratically. The driver of the vehicle was found to be in possession of cannabis and a road-side drug test came back with a positive result for cocaine and cannabis. The driver was arrested for possession of cannabis and 'Drug driving' and bailed awaiting blood test results.



**BAD PARKING.** Staff at St Francis Primary School, Bedworth have received abuse from parents regarding parking outside the school. Some staff have had to endure insults and were unable to enter or leave school, due to illegal and inconsiderate parking by parents attending the school to drop off or pick up students. We cannot be there every day but would like to remind parents that the lay-by in front of the school can only be used by disability badge holders or buses/coaches.



**ABANDONED VEHICLE.** On 31<sup>st</sup> March PC Jake Blaney and PC Alison Rudkin of Bedworth SNT, attended Winterton Road, Bulkington, following reports of the vehicle, shown in the picture. The vehicle was contributing to anti-social behaviour and was also found to be untaxed, so it was seized. We will continue to do patrols in the area, but please report any such incidents to us to facilitate a speedy removal.
