The Warwickshire Road Safety Partnership was formed with the aim of making the roads of Warwickshire safer for all road users. We work with partners to imbed Safe System Approach across communities to reduce the number of people killed or seriously injured in collisions on our county's roads.

After a collision

occurs is known as the 'Golden Hour'. Actions and treatment within the first hour when someone has sustained serious life threatening / life changing injuries really can make all the difference the to overall outcome. It is therefore of paramount importance that if you are involved in or come across a collision you know exactly where you are so that emergency services can be sent straight to you without delay.

Over 70 and driving?

The first hour after a collision Partners work in collaboration with IAM RoadSmart to provide free Mature Driver Reviews, worth £69, for mature drivers aged 65+ and residing in Warwickshire. The aim of the review is to give the driver advice and reassurance over their driving ability; it is not a test. The reviews have been carefully designed to help drivers renew their confidence, receive informed and trusted opinion on their driving, improve skills and reassure family members.
