2026 BikeSafe Season

In November our 2025 BikeSafe season ended, but we'll be back on the road in March 2026 to help keep riders and other road users safe. Why not give the biker in your life a BikeSafe Workshop in 2026? This would help them refresh and improve their skills to make rides out more enjoyable and help them ride more safely. The Workshop would include feedback provided during a ride, from highly trained police officers.

Recent National Operation 'Drive Insured'

During this week-long campaign recently, our officers took 37 uninsured cars, vans and lorries off the roads. In just a few hours in Nuneaton and Bedworth, we seized 12 uninsured vehicles and reported 15 drivers for driving without insurance.

Uninsured drivers put lives at risk. Every week, at least one person is killed by an uninsured driver and many are linked to other criminal activity. These drivers also push up the cost of insurance for everyone else.

E-scooters and E-bikes Seized

In November, PC Lily Patterson led Nuneaton and Bedworth SNT officers on five days of action for Operation Canyet. This was to put a focus on the illegal use of E-scooters and E-bikes across the borough. During the operation: 24 E-scooters were seized, 1 E-bike, and 1 E-bike modification. Also, 2 Section 59 warnings were issued and two arrests were made together with immigration officers. 2 vehicles were seized, one with no insurance and another was an abandoned vehicle issued with a section 99. The operation included a lot of E-bikes being stopped and checked at the roadside, as well as lots of chases on foot. This is an ongoing effort from the Safer Neighbourhood teams, so **we advise parents to investigate the legality around E-bikes and E-scooters before buying them.**



Please Report Antisocial Behaviour (ASB)

Reporting ASB lets us know when and where it's happening so, we can have a real impact. If you're being affected by ASB, it can be reported to Nuneaton and Bedworth Borough Council by calling 024 7637 6322 or you can report it to the police on 101.



Speed is a critical issue. It was a road safety factor in almost 60% of all road deaths in 2024. Please consider other road users who may be more vulnerable than yourself and always drive at a safe speed for the road conditions, within the speed limit.

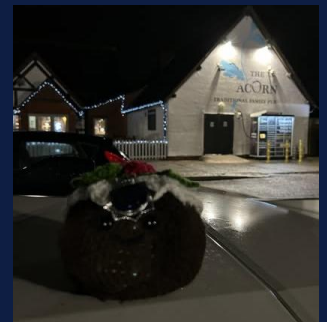
High Visibility Patrols
