Operation Sceptre

Operation Sceptre is the National Police Initiative to tackle Knife Crime and it started again for one week from 11th to 17th of November. School visits were arranged to talk about the dangers of knife crime and the laws about carrying knives and other offensive weapons. Also, to give a general awareness and discuss how to avoid associated risks. Some examples of the visits are shown.

This helped the children learn how to avoid knives and the associated risks and to make them aware that anyone age 10 or above can be arrested for being in possession of

forensic equipment and take fingerprints. They will continue to conduct parking patrols outside the school following their graduation, which they are all looking forward to.

Closure order on Warwick House, Nuneaton, following Anti-Social Behaviour and multiple drug-related deaths



The Nuneaton SNT, working with Nuneaton Borough Council have been successful in obtaining a closure order for Warwick House, a residential property on Bond Gate, Nuneaton. The order, which came into force on 26th November, is to prevent disorderly, offensive, or criminal behaviour on the premises; serious nuisance to members of the public;

and disorder near the property. Since 2023, there have been five deaths at Warwick House, of which four were confirmed to be drug related. Inspector Ryan Walker of Nuneaton And Bedworth SNT said "We could not allow Warwick House to continue to operate in a way that was proving to be damaging to both tenants and



the community in Nuneaton. The next stage of the process is to ensure that vulnerable residents are properly rehoused and supported."



Knife Crime Awareness

In November, the Nuneaton East and West SNT, shown here, supported a local school with 'Prohibited Item Searches', using police search wands.

We are happy to report that nothing alarming was found other than a couple of vapes which have now been confiscated. Supporting schools with this action starts an important conversation amongst students, teachers, parents and police about knife crime and making sure the community and schools they attend are safe places to be.

Bedworth SNT have visited over 35 Schools, Shops and Community hubs delivering posters and cards and explaining the initiative to them. The aim was to encourage the anonymous reporting of anyone they know who is carrying a knife so that the police can intervene. (School visit shown on left). **Worried about someone carrying a knife? Apart from the Newsletter, there will be information on forthcoming events available on Social Media.


For example, the Facebook SNT page will give details of the latest events being planned - Just sign in to Facebook and search for Nuneaton and Bedworth Police.
