This will involve organising SNT policing activities, promoting community engagement, and capitalising on opportunities to maintain public safety in the area.

Chief Inspector Steve Davies said "Our new dedicated beat manager for the town centres will allow us to keep a close oversight on town centre safety. "Tom is an experienced officer who knows our area inside and out, and I am greatly looking forward to the benefits he will bring to the people of Nuneaton and Bedworth." The Rt. Hon Marcus Jones MP for Nuneaton said he is delighted with this new town centre officer post. This will provide reassurance to local residents to tackle town centre crime and anti-social behaviour. "This will be welcomed by local residents to help keep our town centre safe.



# **NUNEATON NEWS**

A Nuneaton gang that stole more than half a million pounds worth of vehicles from Warwickshire and Coventry Staffordshire and Leicestershire have been jailed for a combined total of more than 14 years. The stolen vehicles were either broken down for parts or the offenders used a sophisticated process to change the identification of the vehicles, selling them on to unsuspecting buyers who had no idea they were stolen. Detective Constable Jack Maguire from Warwickshire Police, who led the investigation, said: "This gang travelled around the region brazenly stealing these vehicles.

A suspect was then identified for the offence and was dealt with accordingly by the officer in charge. **Knife Amnesty.** Nuneaton and Bedworth Safer neighbourhood Teams organised the knife amnesty in November and it was very successful, with 43 knives handed in. Another 4 knives were located by Officers or called in by members of the public. A selection of the knives handed in are shown in the picture.

Bedworth West SNT continue to conduct school parking checks in the local area. The two vehicles shown in the pictures outside Newdigate School were found to be parked on the yellow zig zag lines, which clearly state - "KEEP CLEAR". Vehicle owners will be receiving fixed penalty notices through the post. We will continue to conduct patrols around local schools on a regular basis, so please be careful where you park.
